Introduction to the Regional Academy

Wales Netball aspires to create a sustainable over-supply of athletes via its Performance Pathway for its National Squads, and Regional Academies are vital in ensuring this success. Wales Netball supports our Regional Academy Coaches, and guides performance activity within Regional Academies to ensure consistency, and to ensure that the 'Welsh Way' is embedded throughout the programme. This allows our Regional Academy coaches to develop athletes who can transition smoothly into National Academy Squads.

Our Regional Academies performance objectives are as follows:

- To select and develop Regional Academy athletes capable of transitioning into our National Academy programme and age group Competition Squads.
- The retention of our Regional Academy athletes for the long term - we want athletes to continue to choose to develop their netball in Wales, and to do this, we need to ensure our Regional Academies are excellent.
- We want every one of our Regional Academy athletes to develop as both people and players, who embody our values and behaviours.
- We want our Regional Academy athletes to enjoy their experience of Regional Academy - For many of our athletes, their first experience of Wales Netball, and we want it to be a great environment for them.

Role Description

Wales Netball are looking for enthusiastic and committed individual to join our Regional Academy coaching team. We are looking for a Head Coach to lead the Bridgend College Regional Academy (U15 & U17).

Wales Netball have 8 x Regional Academies, all of which have a Head Coach who is responsible for planning and leading the weekly training sessions, supported by an Assistant Coach. Our Regional Academies are skills based and focus on developing athletes in the U15 and U17 age groups. Our Regional Academy Head Coach will be athlete centred, have an open and inclusive, interpersonal coaching style, and a willingness to work collaboratively to aid talent development within Wales. The Bridgend College Regional Academy Head Coach will lead in the delivery of high-quality weekly, netball sessions in accordance with the Wales Netball aims and aligned to the 'Welsh Way'. The Regional Academy Head Coach will benefit from shared resources to help support the facilitation of sessions, professional development opportunities, and opportunities to work with our National Academy Coaches.

Role Summary

The Regional Academy Head Coach will lead in the planning and delivery of high-quality, weekly netball sessions in accordance with the Wales Netball aims and aligned to the 'Welsh Way.' The Regional Academy Head Coach will benefit from shared resources to help support the facilitation of sessions, professional development opportunities, and opportunities to work with our National Academy Coaches.

Typical Responsibilities

- To lead in the delivery of high-quality netball sessions (U15 & U17) in accordance with the Wales Netball aims.
- To plan for each session to ensure progression throughout, aligned to the Wales Netball aims and principles of play.
- To work collaboratively as required with wider support services for the Regional Academy including sport science and medical service and training facilities.
- Oversee individual athlete reviews (Individual Performance Plans) for Regional Academy athletes.
- Delivery of coaching workshops, coaching sessions and mentor for coaches, schoolteachers and clubs as required.
- Lead in developing and maintaining a successful image and profile for Regional Academy athletes within Wales Netball and contribute to the communication activity and assist with promotional activities as required.
- Lead the effective management of Regional Academy athletes, in line with our values and behaviours.
- Maintain strong relationships with key internal and external partners and stakeholders who contribute to the success of performance objectives and pathway programmes.
- Ensure that all activities are conducted in an appropriate way in accordance with health and safety, safeguarding and duty of care policies within Wales Netball policy.
